NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

We would like to remove the old projectors and screens and install 2 new LED screens to enhance our worship so we can display song words and liturgy and use film in church.

We also need to replace our cabling and in addition add a new monitor so that clergy and worship leaders can see what is displayed on the screens behind.

We have approached an Church AV specialist, Audioworks, to assist with this work and they have provided the following description of works.

We will remove the old electric screen barrels and fill the holes left from the fixings. The existing mains supplies can be used to power the new flat screen displays.

The walls are solid blockwork and using Fischer wall plugs and suitable screws we can achieve a good fix along with commercial grade brackets.

The old projectors and their wiring will be removed.

Each screen will be fed a signal from the control point at the back of church using a slim cat6 cable. We will use the same route used for the old projector signal cables.

For the clergy / musicians monitor we will drill and tap the steel beam for two M8 fixings. We will fit a 32" monitor here using a vesa mount bracket. Cables can be glued along the inside of the I beam where they can't be seen.

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
